"No Shame Serving With You" *Rev. George Schuessler*

The Apostle Paul writes to Timothy, "Do not be ashamed" and "relying on the power of God who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works but according to his own purpose and grace. This grace was given to us in Christ Jesus before the ages began, but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel." (2ND Timothy 1:9-10) Like the Apostles and countless Ministers of Word and Sacrament that have gone before me, 40 years ago for this gospel I too was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher.

On June 3RD, 1984, in First English Lutheran Church of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, I was ordained by Assistant to the Bishop, Rev. Robert Herder, a former Pastor of First English Lutheran. I declared before God, The American Lutheran Church, and the world that I am not ashamed of God, my Savior Jesus Christ, and the Gospel of Christ. I knew then as I know now, that the One in whom I have put my trust, and I also am sure that he is able to guard until that day what I have entrusted to Him. Since then I have been in service to my Lord and His Church by proclaiming the message of the Gospel; being persistent whether the time is favorable or unfavorable; convincing, rebuking, and encouraging, with the utmost patience in teaching.

Please do not get the wrong idea. Just because I have a piece of paper that declares me ordained, know that I am not better than you before our Lord Jesus, just as you are not better than me before our Lord Jesus. For you, like myself, are living in what we have learned and firmly believed, knowing from whom we learned it, and how for many of us from childhood have known the Bible's writings that are able to instruct for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. The Apostle Paul writes, "All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that **everyone** who belongs to God may be proficient, equipped for every good work." (2ND Timothy 3:16-17) Simply put, all of us are called to service by God to serve the people of creation and the Church to the best of our abilities. Though ordination allows me to officiate at Holy Communion, Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals, these good works are no more and no less important than your good works both in and outside of the Church.

Therefore, as I celebrate my ordination, I celebrate with you in mind, because it is together that we serve God in our many unique gifts that allow us to do good works to carry out the mission of the Gospel of Christ Jesus. An ordained person does not make a Church. In the truth of the Bible, it is God's people gathered in the name of Jesus that is the "body of Christ", the Church. It's us in Jesus' name serving with good works together that are able to proclaim the message of the Gospel; being persistent whether the time is favorable or unfavorable; convincing, rebuking, and encouraging, with the utmost patience in teaching. In short, we are all ministers in the Word of God, and for that I am thankful. I am also thankful for the privilege of serving with you and all of the people with whom I have worked with throughout these 40 years in Christ's service. To God is the glory forever and ever. Amen!

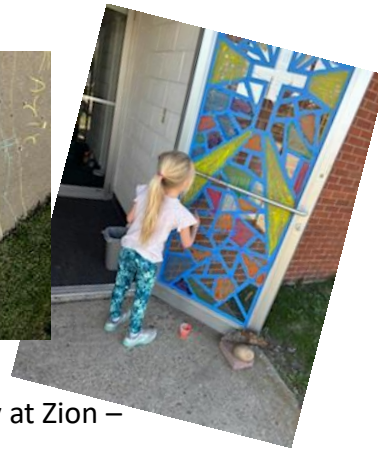

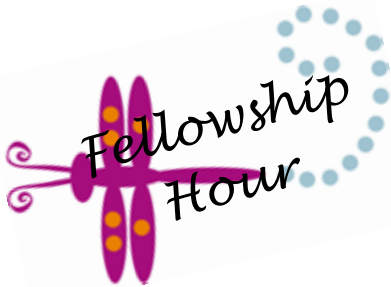

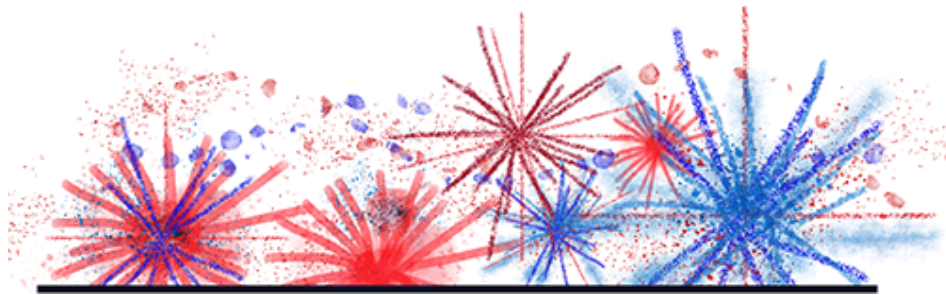
