FROM MINISTER HEATHER

Dear Church Family, It is here, that unmistakable shift in the air, the longer evenings, the smell of freshly cut grass, the sound of kids laughing down the street, and the sweet relief of kicking off your shoes and just breathing a little easier. Summer is HERE, friends, and I don't know about you, but I am ready for every single bit of it! There is something about this season that just opens us up. The pace slows down just enough for us to look around and notice the good things, the blue sky, the backyard barbecues, the fireflies blinking at dusk. Summer has a way of reminding us that life is meant to be savored, not just survived. So consider this letter your official, joy-filled invitation into a summer season brimming with blessings — big ones and small ones — and a whole lot of reasons to gather, laugh, and give thanks to God together.

I have been sitting with two beautiful passages of Scripture lately, and honestly, they feel like they were written for a summer like this one. The first is from Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor. If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up." There is such simple, honest wisdom in those words. It does not get complicated or philosophical, it just tells the plain truth. We need each other. Life works better when we do it together. Whether it is carrying something heavy, figuring something out, or just showing up on a hard day, two really are better than one. And three are better than two. And a whole community gathered around a campfire? Well, that is something else entirely. The second passage is Psalm 133:1 — "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" I love that the Psalmist doesn't overthink it. He just calls it what it is, good and pleasant. Not complicated. There is real joy in being together as

God's people, and I think sometimes we forget how much we actually need that. Not just on Sunday mornings, but out in the sunshine, around a fire, with a good song in the air and a smile on our faces. This summer, I want us to lean into that. I want us to be a community that chooses togetherness — that shows up for one another, that lights the fire and says, "Come on over."

I also want to share something personal, because you are my family and good news is meant to be shared! At the end of June, I will be taking a week of vacation to celebrate my daughter's baby shower for her very first baby. And as I get ready to welcome this little one into the world, I find myself thinking about community in a whole new way, about what it means to raise a child surrounded by people who love them, who show up, who gather around. That is exactly what you are for our family. And I am so grateful. I will be away for a short stretch at the end of June, but I will be back refreshed, overjoyed, and ready to dive into a summer full of good things with all of you. Thank you for always being such a loving, supportive church family. It means more than you know.

Now — here is something I am genuinely excited about, and I hope you will be too. This summer, I am inviting you to join together for something that we are calling Wednesdays in the Word. Here is the idea: summer Wednesdays, together, in whatever way feels right every other week. Maybe we are gathered around a campfire. Maybe there is music drifting through the air. Maybe we are digging into a passage of Scripture, or playing a game, or just sitting and talking and enjoying each other's company. The point is not a rigid agenda — the point is connection. Connection with God. Connection with each other. Connection with family and friends and the wider

community around us. Because that is what summer is made for, and that is what Ecclesiastes and the Psalmist are both pointing us toward — the rich, life-giving gift of doing this together. There is no pressure here. No sign-up sheet you have to fill out. No commitment you have to make weeks in advance. Just an open, warm invitation to show up when you can, bring whoever you want to bring, and let yourself be part of something simple and sweet. Come as you are. Come when you can. Just come. I truly believe these Wednesday evenings are going to be one of the highlights of our summer. There will be a place for you, a seat by the fire, and people who are genuinely glad you showed up.

Friends, we have so much to celebrate this summer. We have the 4th of July coming up, a day to wave our flags, watch the fireworks burst across the sky, and give thanks for the freedom and the community we get to call home. There is something about that holiday that just makes you feel grateful to be here, surrounded by people you love, in a place that is yours. We have each other — this beautiful, imperfect, warm-hearted congregation of people who show up week after week and choose to do life together in the name of Jesus. "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity." That is us. That is what we get to be for each other this summer and every season.

Here is my prayer for all of us in June and July: May you rest well. May you laugh often. May you find yourself around a fire with people who fill your heart. May you taste the goodness of this season and feel the presence of God in every warm evening and every shared meal and every song that rises up into the summer sky. And may you know, deeply and truly, that you are loved — by this community, and by the God who knit us all together. See you on a Wednesday.

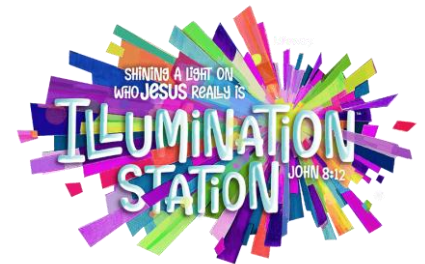
June 1-5 | 6:00 AM–8:00 PM - Carpio Vacation Bible School
