FROM MINISTER HEATHER

May is one of those months that sneaks up on you with all of its fullness. One moment you are catching your breath from Easter, and the next you are watching a young person step forward to be confirmed, receiving the Lord's Supper for the very first time, or cheering as a graduate crosses the stage. And then woven through it all, right there at the end of the month, we pause to honor and remember those who gave everything so that the rest of us could keep stepping forward. It is a lot to hold - joy, pride, excitement, nervousness and a mixture of happy and sad tears. May has a way of reminding us that life is full of moments where we stand at the edge of something and wonder, am I ready for this? And here is something we can hold one to, God shows up in every single one of those moments.

In Joshua 1:9, God speaks clearly and directly: "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." These words were spoken to Joshua as he prepared to lead people into completely unknown territory. He had big shoes to fill, a huge task ahead of him, and I imagine more than a few moments of wondering if he was truly up to it. And yet, God did not say, "Do not be afraid because it will be easy." No, God said, be strong and courageous because I will be with you. Courage comes from knowing that God goes with you. Into the confirmation vows. Into the first taste of communion. Into the first day of college or a new career. Into the quiet grief of remembering someone we have lost. God goes with us into all of it.

And if Joshua reminds us we are not alone, Philippians 1:6, reminds us that God's work in us is far from finished. The Apostle Paul writes with such confidence and warmth: "Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it

on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion. Starting at our baptism, the faith planted in a confirmand's heart, the life poured into a graduating senior over eighteen years of growing and learning and becoming. God sees it as a work still in progress, still full of beautiful possibilities. When we honor someone on Memorial Day, lives given in service and sacrifice, God's work in them was not wasted. Their stories continue to shape us, to call us forward, and to remind us of the courage it takes to give yourself fully to something greater than yourself.

Whether you are the one stepping into something new this May or the one cheering from the sidelines, this message is for all of us. Because no matter where we find ourselves in Life's journey, we all face moments of stepping into the unknown. We all need to be reminded that courage is not something we manufacture on our own, it is something God gives us through his very presence. So to our confirmands, and our first communicants - Welcome to this deeper, richer walk of faith. God began something in you long ago, and He is not finished yet. To our Graduates - step forward with courage. You are not alone, not for a single moment. To those who will pause in remembrance this Memorial Day, Thank you for honoring those who walked their own courageous path. Their faith and sacrifice will speak. And to each and every one of you, may this May be a month where we see God's faithful hand at work in every new beginning, every milestone, and every quiet moment of stepping forward. Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid. The Lord your God goes with you, wherever you go.

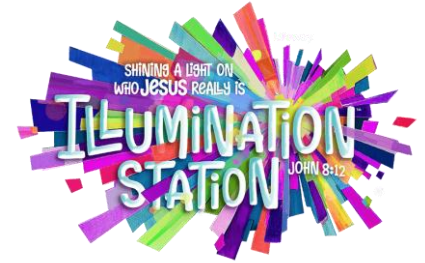

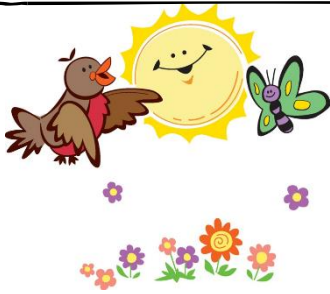

5. Britney Baer and family asked to become members of the church. A motion was made by Candice Asmundson to accept the membership. Seconded by Alechia Neubauer. Motion carried.

A Fun Mother's Day Gift Idea

a fun Flower Frog

A flower frog sits atop a vase to help arrange flowers and hold stems in place. This personalized frog will become a favorite!

What you need:

- Air-dry clay
- Roller
- Vase (or jar)
- Plastic knife
- Straw
- Acrylic paint and brushes



What you do:

1. Roll out a portion of clay to about ½-inch thickness.
2. Cut out a circle that's slightly larger than the vase opening. (This will allow the finished frog to sit securely on top.)
3. To make holes for stems, use a straw to punch out circle shapes. If you make more than one frog, try arranging the holes in different patterns.
4. Let dry completely. Then personalize your work with acrylic paint.
5. When dry, place the frog atop the vase. Arrange flowers and greenery to make a Mother's Day bouquet.
